

### Sub: Scooty Scheme For College Going Girl Students

H'ble Chief Minister has desired the government part sponsor Scooties (for 50% of the ex showroom price) for around 1500 college going girls in J&K as a part of 'empowering the girl child' program. These vehicles will enable such girls independence of mobility and at the same time promote confidence in girls across the spectrum.

#### The broader criteria for the scheme is:

1. The applicant should be a state subject.
2. The applicant should be a student of a degree / course of not less than three year duration.
3. The applicant should have secured not less than 65% marks in 10+2 and current Degree Course Years (the course that the student is studying in).
4. The applicant should be not less than 18 years and have a valid driving license or a learner's license (which the applicant shall upgrade to valid license, under existing rules).
5. The yearly income of the applicants parents / guardian should not be more than 400,000 (Four Lac Rupees).
6. The applicant should be able to finance the remaining 50% of the Scooty amount on ex-showroom price (all registration, insurance and other charges shall be borne by the applicant).
7. The applicant shall have to submit a bond certifying that '*applicant will not resell, rent or use for commercial interests, the Scooty for five years from the purchase of the Scooty. Nor shall the Scooty be transferred to any other name during these five years. In case of default on the bond or transfer, the applicant is liable to pay the full amount contributed by the government, back to the government or the Scooty shall be seized.*'
8. The scheme shall be available within a fixed time period as specified by the Government of J&K and all selection of 'Scooty sponsorship' shall be determined by a draw of lots, undertaken individually for each district at a location specified by the Government. The Government shall entertain no claim on non-selection in the draw of lots or any claim on wait listing (since there shall be no waiting list).
9. Students / Applicants are expected to follow traffic rules and exhibit responsible behavior while on wheels. Any violation of traffic rules or negligent use of the vehicle shall be responsibility of the applicant under existing laws of the state.

### Conditions for Girls Scooty Scheme

1. The applicant should be a state subject.
2. The applicant should have secured not less than 65% marks in 10+2 and current Degree Course Years (the course that the student is studying in).
3. The applicant should be not less than 18 years and have a valid driving license or a learner's license (which the applicant shall upgrade to valid license, under existing rules).
4. The yearly income of the applicants parents / guardian should not be more than 400,000 (Four Lac Rupees).
5. The applicant should be able to finance the remaining 50% of the Scooty amount on ex-showroom price (all registration, insurance and other charges shall be borne by the applicant).
6. The applicant shall have to submit a bond certifying that '*applicant will not resell, rent or use for commercial interests, the Scooty for five years from the purchase of the Scooty. Nor shall the Scooty be transferred to any other name during these five years. In case of default on the bond or transfer, the applicant is liable to pay the full amount contributed by the government, back to the government or the Scooty shall be seized.*'
7. The scheme shall be available within a fixed time period as specified by the Government of J&K and all selection of 'Scooty sponsorship' shall be determined by a draw of lots, undertaken individually for each district at a location specified by the Government.
